Cub Scouts



Light of Christ – is designed for youth 6 -7 years old, Tiger or Wolf rank, and it introduces the Scout to their relationship with God through the Eucharist and Reconciliation.



Parvuli Dei – is designed for youth 8 – 10 year old, Bear or Webelos rank, and deepens the Scouts' understanding and relationship with God.

-The Cub Emblem programs are accomplished at home with his parents. Or in group settings with leader but must have Scout and parents attending together.

Boy Scout/Venture/Ship



Ad Altare Dei – is designed for Roman Rite youth, boys and girls who have

finished the 6th grade, age 12 – 15. It studies the seven Sacraments and how we can live the Sacraments daily.



Light is Life – is designed for Eastern Rite, boys age 12 – 13. The Scout develops a deeper

awareness of his faith-life. So he will be able to witness life through maturity in communal worship.

Scouts work on Ad Altare Dei or Light is Life – never both.



Pope Pius XII - is designed for youth, boys and girls who are 15 – 18 for Boy Scouts; 15 - 21 Venture and Ships. It studies one's life state vocation. i.e. Single, Married, Religious or Ordained we all need to learn how to balance our vocation and faith.

The Boy Scout/Venture/Ship Emblem Programs are led by a trained Counselor and can be found in several formats. Classroom, Retreat, and Virtual
